

NARRAMORE FIRES SUNDAY 70 TO WIN BY TWO SHOTS

Chas Narramore (Kingston, Tenn.) fired a two-under 70 on Sunday to overtake first round leader Caleb Marsh (Strawberry Plains, Tenn.) and claim his first victory in his first start on the United States Junior Golf Tour. Trailing Marsh by four shots after Saturday's round, Narramore turned the front nine in even par and shot 34 on the back nine. Marsh shot 74 for the first round lead and shot 76 on Sunday to lock down second place. Last year's USJGT High School Player of the Year Philip Lee (Maryville, Tenn.) shot 153 over the two days to claim third. Fourth place was shared by David Holmes (Knoxville, Tenn.) and eighth-grader Hunter Green (Evensville, Tenn.) at 156.

The consensus on Narramore's final round was shared by playing partners and groups in front and behind him. All commented on his solid iron shots into every green on the back side. Narramore will go for his second consecutive win in two weeks at Three Ridges in Knoxville.

The second place finish by Marsh was the highest for the ninth-grader in high school division competition.

Megan Cox (Knoxville, Tenn.) held off sixth-grader Jordan Britt (Dayton, Tenn.) to win the Girls High School title by five shots. Britt is playing up two age groups this year and already has two USJGT titles to her credit. Heather Arnold (Lenoir City, Tenn.) closed with a final round 85 to finish just two shots behind Britt.

After sharing the first round lead with Brandon Rodgers (Knoxville, Tenn.), Hogan Vaughn (Huntsville, Ala.) came from five shots behind late in the round to win the Boys Rising Stars title. After opening with an 82, Vaughn closed with an 80 to claim his second title of the season and defeat Rodgers by two shots.

Zach Madewell (Dayton, Tenn.) edged Zach Botts (Jonesborough, Tenn.) by one shot in the Boys Future Stars Division. Tied going into the final hole, Madewell edged Botts to claim the title.

Kendall Martindale (Jefferson City, Tenn.) continued her dominance of the Girls Rising Stars division. Trailing A.J. Selig (Appleton, Wisc.) by five shots after round one, Martindale rebounded with a 42 on Sunday to claim a seven-shot win. It was her sixth win in six events this year.
