

The Bear Trace Open '03

FAITZ OVERCOMES SEVEN SHOT DEFICIT TO WIN; SHOOTS ONE-UNDER ON SUNDAY

Nick Faitz (N. Little Rock, Ark.) fired a one-under 71 on Sunday overcoming a seven-shot deficit to win the Boys High School division of The Bear Trace Open. In near perfect weather conditions, Faitz carded a one-under 35 on the front nine and an even par 36 on the back. Zachary Smalley (Millington, Tenn.) started the day four shots back of first round leader Stephen Poole. Smalley shot an 80 to tie for second with Rivers Brahan (Aberdeen, Miss.) who shot 83 both days. Poole (Tupelo, Miss.), the first round leader struggled with a 46 on the backside Sunday to fall out of contention.

Preston McClellan (Memphis, Tenn.) shot one-under over the final 12 holes to overtake first round leader Alex Rowland (Houston, Miss.) and win by two shots. Down by five shots with 10 to play and down three with three to play, McClellan stayed steady recording one birdie, one bogey and seven pars on the backside while Rowland, after shooting even on the front, struggled on the final nine with a 42.

Baillie Johnson (Counce, Tenn.) easily won the Girls Junior High title defeating Mary Michael Maggio (Conway, Ark.) by 17 shots. In other divisions, Josh Alford (Marion, Ark.) cruised to a 10-shot win in the Boys Rising Stars and A.J. Selig (Appleton, Wisc.) recorded her first USJGT win with a 26-shot victory in the Girls Rising Stars. Patrick Sweeney (Cordova, Tenn.) overcame a three shot deficit to win the Boys Future Stars by two shots over Zackary Morton (Henderson, Tenn.)
